| General Comments | Excellent drought tolerance allows for planting in the more arid areas where rainfall is less predictable. Emergence is excellent so it can be planted earlier in the season however best results are always when soil temperatures are above 60F. In high plains where maturity permits, early planting lets you double crop back to wheat. |
| Overview | PH251 Fits well into all areas of the northern sorghum belt. It has excellent drought tolerance that helps to break dormancy even under very hot & dry growing conditions. Emergence is very good for no-till farmers. PH251 offers excellent standability and threshability along with above average yield for maturity. |
